

Reception half term menu - Woodland habitat

(You can choose as few or as many as you like)

Choose your starter:

- Go on an autumn bug hunt
- Do a leaf/bark rubbing picture
- Practice writing your numbers from 0 - 10
- Practice writing your name - use pens, pencils, flour, sand, sugar to write
- Make a day of the week chart - what are you doing on different days?

Choose your main course:

- Do some cooking - what new autumn vegetables can you use?
- Go on an autumn woodland hunt - what can you see happening to the trees and the leaves?
- Plant daffodil bulbs for some spring beauty
- Practice writing your name/letters in flour/glitter
- Make your own story box using a shoe box
- Design a poster on the importance of brushing your teeth
- Make a wind chime - what materials did you use?
- Make a wind sock to identify which way the wind is blowing and how strong it is
- Using the sound mat, what sounds/words can you write?

Choose your dessert:

- Do some construction - try different shapes to see if they will stack. Why, why not?
- Go on a 2d and 3d shape hunt
- Learn as many of your high frequency words on your diary as you can
- Play a board game (snakes and ladders, frustration etc) and practice counting
- Practice blending and segmenting CVC words (these are 3 letter words like sun, mat, red etc)
- Practice reading your HFW in your communication book
- Watch number blocks and alphablocks
