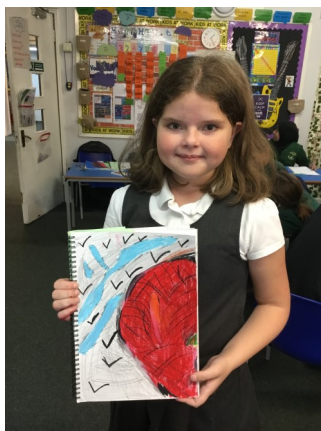


Our Learning
