Our Learning

This week, we continued our study of British monarchy by studying the reign on King John and the importance of the Magna Carta. We also were lucky enough to watch a fantastic performance of Macbeth by the Young Shakespeare Company.

In English, the children worked hard to showcase their learning in assessments in reading and GPS. We will then began our study of Shakespeare's Macbeth which will be our focus in lessons for the next few weeks.

In maths, we began to look at equivalent and simplifying fractions.

Next week, we will be studying the reigns of two Tudor monarchs– King Henry VIII and Queen Elizabeth I.

In English, we will be beginning an in-depth study of Shakespeare's play 'Macbeth'. The children will be writing in role and exploring the story through drama.
