
Lunch



Maths

Learning will focus on ensuring all children are confident with the

Reception curriculum for Number and Shape before moving on to the National Curriculum.

This will include:

- Counting and ordering numbers to 20 (forwards and backwards)
- Identifying one more / one less than any number
- Adding and subtracting single digit numbers
- Number bonds to 10 and counting in 10s
- Properties of 2D and 3D shapes

- Please ensure all clothing /bottles are clearly named



- Homework is reducing
- > Read with your child every day if possible
- Practice core math skills.
- > Encourage your child to engage in play.
- > Have your children actively engages in real life experiences such as going to the shops, telling the time etc..

Reading

- > Reading is an integral part of Year 1 curriculum
- Each child should have their book bag that was allocated to them in Reception for reading scheme books and the reading record
- > Books will be changed by the class teachers once a week for most children based on the child's progress
- > The focus is on enjoyment and understanding
- We follow the Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Revised programme - parent page available

Y1 Phonics Screening

- > The phonics screening takes place in June
- It will be administered by the class teachers to children individually
- > All children in KS1 and EY have daily phonics lessons

How you can help...?

- > Read to your child every day.
- Read from a wide range of genres fiction, non fiction, comics, poems,
- > Practise number bonds to 10 and 20, as well as, counting in 5's, 10's and 2's.
- > Talk to them about things that they are interested in
- > Read Peek at the Week
- Make sure your child has the correct uniform and all items are named
