<u>3 times table – Frere Jacques</u>

3, 6, 9, 12, 15, 18 (Frere Jacques, Frere Jacques)

Twen-ty one, twen-ty four (dormez vous, dormez vous)

Twenty seven, thirty, dee dee dee dee deee deee (sonnez les matines, sonnez les matines)

Thir-ty three, thir-ty six (ding dang dong, ding dang dong)

NB: the "dee dee" bit avoids repeating the numbers in this line, which may be confusing to some children.



- 4 times table Row your boat
- Four, eight, twelve, sixteen (row, row, row your boat)
- Twen-ty, twen-ty four (gently down the stream)
- Twen-ty eight and thir-ty two (if you see a crocodile)
- Thir-ty six and for-ty (don't forget to scre-am)



- 6 times table We wish you a merry Christmas
- Six, twelve, eighteen, twenty four, thirty, (we wish you a merry Christmas, we)
- Thirty six, forty two, forty ... (wish you a merry Christmas, we)
- eight, fifty four and sixty, (wish you a merry Christmas)
- Sixty six, seventy two. (and a happy-py new year)

- 7 times table Here we go round the mulberry bush
- 7, 14 and 21 (here we go round the mulb'ry bush)
- 28, 35 (mulb'ry bush, mulb'ry bush)
- 42, 49, 56 (quickly!) (here we go round the mul-ber-ry bush)
- 63 and 70 (cold and frosty morning)



- <u>8 times table Happy birthday</u>
- Eight, six-teen, twen-ty four (happy birthday to you)
- Thir-ty two, forty (fast!), for-ty eight (happy birthday a to-o you words need squishing into this line a bit!)
- Fif-ty six, sixty four_ (happy birthday times tables_)
- Seven-ty two and eight-y (hap-p-py birthday to you)
