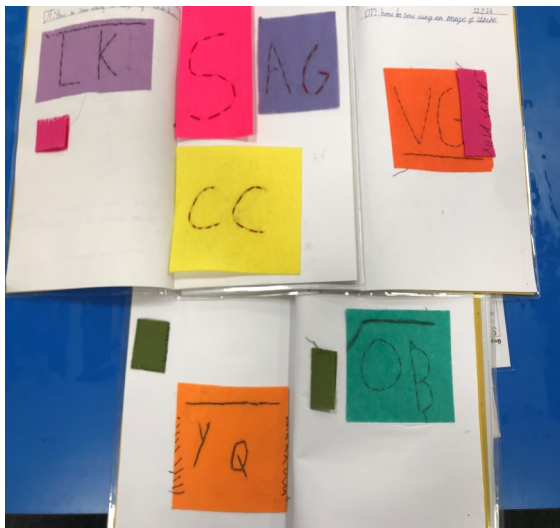
**Next week, in DT,** we will begin to gather ideas to design a money box container, fit for purpose.
