# Our Learning

This week, in History, we have started a new topic on the Anglo-Saxons. We have learned about the origin of the Anglo-Saxons and their reasons for the invasion of Britain.

In maths, we are continuing with multiplication and division. We have learned to identify and use factor pairs, as well as to multiply and divide by 10 and 100.

In English, we started reading the Anglo-Saxon story, Beowulf. We learnt about the key characters and explored language linked to the Anglo-Saxon times. We wrote character descriptions of Grendel the Monster.

**Next week, in History,** we will be learning about the people's religious beliefs during Anglo-Saxon times and how their religious beliefs changed over a period of time.

In maths, we will begin to use related facts in multiplication and division, followed by multiplying 2 and 3-digit numbers by a 1-digit number.

In English, we will be finishing the end of our tale 'Beowulf and Grendel, The Monster of The Night'. We will then have the chance to re-write the narrative independently using our knowledge of the story.

PSHRE Focus: Dreams and Goals: In PSHRE this term, we will understand how it feels to have hopes and dreams and that sometimes they do not come true, and that this can hurt. By reflecting on positive and happy experiences, we will learn to counteract disappointment. We will make new plans and set new goals for the future by working out the steps to achieve them.
