Our Learning

This week, in history, we learnt about why the Vikings were feared and why they attacked coastal communities such as Lindisfarne.

In maths, we continued to explore decimals. This week, we learnt how to divide one-digit and two-digit numbers by 10, followed by understanding hundredths as fractions.

In English, we continued with sentence stacking lessons, focussing on grammar for writing.

Next week, in history, we will have the exciting opportunity to create our very own Viking Longship!

In maths, we will continue to learn about hundredths as decimals. We will explore how to place hundredths on a place value chart and divide 1-digit and 2-digit numbers by 100.

In English, we will come to the end of our story and will start to think about our independent write for this unit.

PSHRE Focus: Relationships: In PSHRE this term, we will recognise situations that can cause jealousy in relationships and can identify someone we love and express why they are special to us.
