Our Learning

This week, in history, we began to learn more about what life was like in Britain when the Romans invaded.

In maths, we built on our knowledge of place value and number and learnt how to represent and partition numbers on a number line up to 10,000.

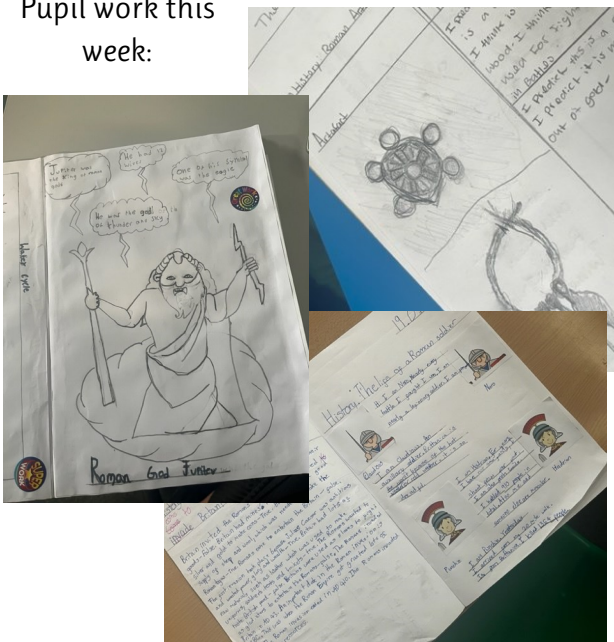
In English, we focussed on writing effective sentences for our diary entry. We looked at the key features of diaries and built a bank of topic vocabulary that we can use across the topic.

Next week, we will complete our history unit on the Roman invasion and settlement of Britain. We will research the influence the Romans had and create an information page using the knowledge we have acquired over our unit.

In maths, we will compare and order numbers up to 10,000 and explore Roman Numerals.

In English, we will plan and write our own diary entry, from the perspective of a Roman slave.
