Our Learning

This week, in geography, we learnt to identify the position and significance of latitude (Equator), longitude, (Prime/Greenwich Meridian) and time zones.

In maths, we enjoyed exploring mixed numbers by ordering and comparing them. We were also introduced to improper fractions.

In English, we built on our knowledge of refugeeism and learnt about human rights, specifically children's rights and how this can be effected all over the world. We looked at a book called 'We are all free' and explored language and illustration linked to human rights in more detail.

Next week, in geography, we will be creating a fact file of a country in Europe including key information about climate, physical features, population, land use, resources and language.

In maths, we will continue to focus on our topic of fractions linked to improper fractions and mixed numbers. Also, we will begin to explore equivalent fractions.

In English, we will be exploring formal language again and features of formal writing. Children will build on their skills in this area and will have the chance to write another formal letter to the queen!

PSHRE Focus: Healthy Me: In PSHRE this term, we will learn how to make healthy choices about friendships by recognising the value of them and the emotions they create for us. We will learn about group dynamics and how to be aware of peer pressure.
