# Homework

- Read every day for at least 20 minutes.
- Maths and grammar homework once a week – given out and marked each **Friday**.
- Doodle Maths and Times Tables Rockstars
- Spellings given out and tested each **Friday**.
- Homework menu set at the start of the half term – 1 piece per week – **work shared at the end of the half term.**

# How you can help...?

- Encourage your child to read **every** day. They can record this in their reading records.
- Encourage your child to read from a wide range of genre – fiction, non fiction, newspapers, the internet, comics, poems, leaflets...
- (See Y3/4 Book List for recommended books)
- Talk to them about the book they are reading.
- Remind your child to complete their half term homework challenge – 1 choice per week.

# How you can help...?

- Help your child practise their spellings and to learn the statutory words for Year 4 (a copy is stuck in their homework book).
- Remind your child to complete their maths and grammar homework and to bring it to school each Friday. Library books can be renewed each Tuesday.
- Make sure your child has the correct school uniform and wears their PE uniform to school on a Wednesday. Other than small studs/ religious wear, jewellery should not be worn. This also applies to clubs.
- No cards/fiddle toys unless approved by the school.
