Our Learning

This week, we have explored ratio and proportion in our Maths lessons. In English, we learnt some tricky grammar terminology including the subjunctive form and present perfect tense.

In history, we have continued to learn more about key events that have occurred in London's history. This week our focus has been on 'The Great Plague' of 1665 and the Great Fire of London of 1666.

In Computing this half term, we are learning more about how to stay safe online.

Next week, we will be studying the 'Great Stink' which hit London in the 1800s and writing poems inspired by the event. We will also be learning about the importance of the London Underground. In Maths and English lessons we will be continuing to revise a range of topics in preparation for the KS2 SATs in May.
